We extend a warm welcome to Nancy!

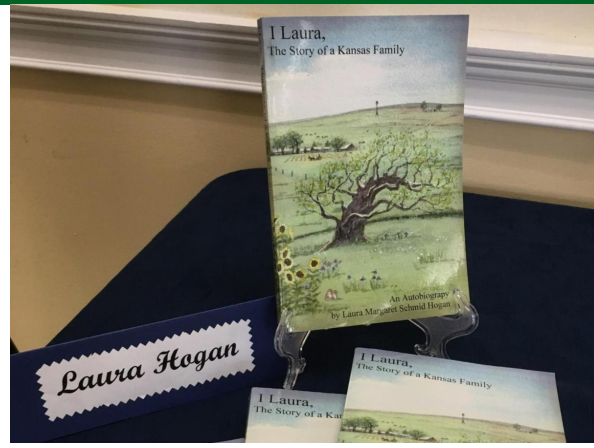
SERVING UP SMILES

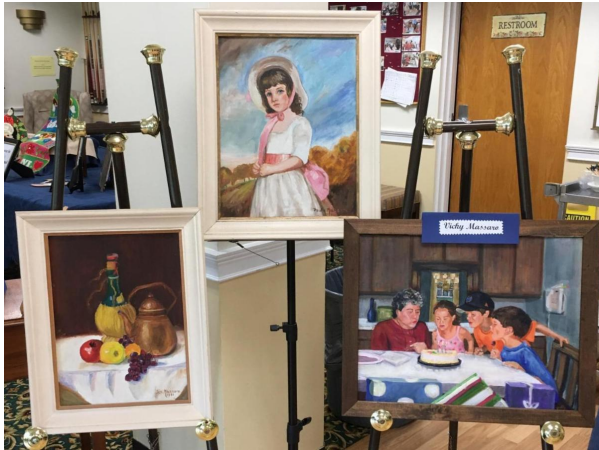
